SSDL annual reports for 2020

It is time for the submission of the Annual Report of the IAEA/WHO SSDL Network for 2020. As you know this is a requirement for being a SSDL Network member (SSDL Charter- https://ssdl.iaea.org/Content/SSDL_Charter_2nd_Edition.pdf).

We are happy to announce that you can use DOLNET, our new web-based interface for annual reporting. The Dosimetry Laboratory database (DOLNET) is used to collect annual reports and provide information on calibration services available in the SSDLs. To have access to your institute data in DOLNET, a NUCLEUS account is required.

Kindly follow the guidance given below, if you wish to create a new Nucleus account:

1. If you wish to create a new NUCLEUS user to your SSDL please create a NUCLEUS account at: <https://websso.iaea.org/IM/UserRegistrationPage.aspx>. Please let us know to which NUCLEUS user you want to assign your SSDL. This is required to proceed with the review of your data and finally the submission of the annual report of 2020.
2. You can either send us the nucleus user name by email or request access to your laboratory by using "Request access" in the following page, <https://ssdl.iaea.org/Home/AccessToDataEntry>. Please fill out the requested information in the e-mail template and submit the e-mail.
3. Once we have received the Nucleus account information, we will assign your SSDL to that account.

If you did not receive a guidance note for data review in DOLNET and wish to receive one, please email us.

Kindly be aware that with the submission you also agree that the laboratory e-mail address is shown on the SSDL Network website as a contact information. The deadline for the submission of the Annual reports is the 8 May 2021.
